Assistance animals are permitted into accommodation areas and on the premises, though we do ask that you please inform reception of the presence of a service dog. It is the policy of this property that all other pets are NOT permitted in accommodation.

TEA AND COFFEE

Your apartment is stocked with coffee, tea bags, sugar, and long life milk. These items will be replenished with your next service.

Any additional stocks you may require can be obtained from reception.

WI-FI

Free Wi-Fi has been installed in each room. To connect to our secured network, login details will be provided in your welcome letter.

TELEVISION

The television receives all Free-to-air stations, a range of Foxtel channels, and Ezestream Movies on Demand. Please ask reception if you require set-up assistance.

SERVICING

Daily Service/Check includes, check for rubbish, pull up bedding, replace towels if on the floor and general check of the room.

Servicing is not available on Saturday and Sunday.

A full service is done weekly for longer stays. That includes: change sheets, clean bathroom, clean kitchen if applicable – check of the oven, vacuum, mop floors, replace towels, bathmat, hand towel, replace tea towel and cloth and top up all guest amenities.

PARKING

NO SMOKING

Our property is NON SMOKING. Please refrain from smoking in your room, on the balconies and anywhere within the property. Evidence of smoking will incur a fee, see Schedule of Fees.



NOISE

We ask that you respect other guests by limiting the amount of noise made after 9:00PM, any disturbances that require management involvement may have a charge imposed. Whilst we encourage guests to enjoy themselves, we advise there is a strict No Party Policy. Failure to comply will incur a fee, see Schedule of Fees.

KEYS

KEYS to the apartment must be returned to reception or placed in the key box on departure. A replacement fee shall be charged to the guest account should they not be returned or damaged beyond use. See Schedule of Fees for details.

DAMAGE & LOSS

The person(s) registering as the guest(s) shall be liable for any loss or damage to the appliances, furniture, keycards, fixtures and all fittings in the Apartment. Fair wear and tear excluded.

THEFT

Central Apartment Group shall not be responsible for, or liable to compensate for the loss, theft or damage of personal property on, or brought into the apartment or in the immediate vicinity of the Apartments.

LIABILITY OF PAYMENT

Where guests sign for and on behalf of a business or company, and in the event that the business or company is unable to or refuses to pay any amount due, the Guest(s) shall be liable to pay on demand any amount owing by the business or company under the agreement.

REFUNDS

Full refund of deposits shall only be paid if the Terms and Conditions detailed in the Reservation Confirmation Letter are fully satisfied.

TERM OF STAY CHANGES

Should the term of accommodation be reduced, the registered guest hereby agrees to be liable for the appropriate tariff under the current Schedule of Rates. Refunds may be applied to an early departure (Under Management's Discretion).

NUMBER OF GUESTS

The number of guests in the apartment at any one time shall not exceed the number of guests declared on the Guest Registration Form. Should at any time the number of guests in the apartment exceed the number of guests detailed, Central Apartment Group reserves the right to terminate the reservation immediately, without refund.

FIRE ALARMS

Central Apartment Group has the right to charge for any Fire False alarm if set off by a guest where the Fire Brigade is called out. The Normal fine is \$1,500.00 that will be charged if required. However a minimum of \$400.00 plus GST will be charged to your Credit card after the Fire Brigade call out.

ROOM DEPARTURE

Guests are responsible for the state of the room upon departure. If rooms are found to be in an excessively bad state, the guest acknowledges that Central Apartment Group has the right to charge a cleaning fee to the credit card supplied when making the booking.

MELBOURNE CRICKET GROUND (MCG)

The Melbourne Cricket Ground (MCG) is arguably Australia's greatest sports stadium, with a rich history and a total capacity of 100,000 people.

The MCG is situated in the world-famous Melbourne Sports Precinct, just a short walk from Melbourne's CBD, which also includes Rod Laver Arena, Hisense Arena and AAMI Park. The ground primarily plays host to Australian Football and Cricket however other events (including Soccer, Rugby Union, Rugby League and live music concerts) are also staged at the venue.



ROYAL BOTANIC GARDENS

Melbourne's Royal Botanic Gardens are a haven for nature enthusiasts. Explore curated gardens bursting with vibrant blooms, from Australian natives to exotic plants. Stroll through tranquil fern gullies and majestic tree avenues, or admire the impressive ornamental lakes.

The Royal Botanic Gardens offer a delightful escape from the city bustle, perfect for a picnic, a relaxing walk, or learning about diverse plant life.

SHRINE OF REMEMBRANCE

The Shrine of Remembrance is Victoria's largest and most visited war memorial of National Significance. It is Melbourne's most recognised landmark. It was built in remembrance of those who served and those who died in the Great War of 1914-1918 and armed conflicts and peacekeeping duties since.

The inspiration for the external outline of the building came from one of the seven wonders of the ancient world—the mausoleum at Harlicarnassus to Mausolus, King of Caria in South West Asia Minor.



MELBOURNE CITY CIRCLE TRAMS

The City Circle Tram is a free and convenient way to see the sights of central Melbourne and the Docklands while experiencing a ride on one of the city's much loved heritage trams.

An audio commentary provides details of city landmarks and major attractions such as the City Museum, Parliament House, Docklands, Federation Square, Melbourne Aquarium and the Princess Theatre.

The City Circle Tram also links with other tram, train and bus routes around Melbourne.



NATIONAL GALLERY OF VICTORIA

The National Gallery of Victoria (NGV) is the oldest and most visited gallery in Australia. Situated over two magnificent buildings – NGV International and NGV Australia – the Gallery hosts a wide range of international and local artists, exhibitions, programs and events; from contemporary art to major international historic exhibitions, fashion and design, architecture, sound and dance. Best of all, it's free to enter.



MELBOURNE ZOO

Immerse yourself in the wonders of the animal kingdom at Melbourne Zoo, a beloved Melbourne institution for over 150 years. See majestic lions, playful monkeys, and cute penguins in recreated habitats. Beyond entertainment, the Zoo champions conservation with educational experiences, fostering a connection with wildlife for all ages. The zoo is accessible via Royal Park station on the Upfield railway line, and is also accessible via tram routes 55 and 19.

STATE LIBRARY OF VICTORIA

The State Library of Victoria is the central library of the state of Victoria. It is located in the northern centre of the CBD. The library holds over 2 million books and 16,000 serials, including the diaries of the cities founders, John Batman and John Pascoe Fawkner, and the folios of Captain James Cook. It also houses the original armour of Ned Kelly.



MELBOURNE MUSEUM

Melbourne Museum explores life in Victoria, from the natural environment to our culture and history.

Located in Carlton Gardens, opposite the World Heritage Listed Royal Exhibition Building, the award-winning Melbourne Museum houses a permanent collection in eight galleries, including one just for children. This is one of Australia's biggest and most loved museums.

EUREKA SKY DECK

Every great city has its icon, its point of recognition, the gem in its urban skyline. For Melbourne, it's the Eureka Tower, a 297 metre gold plated skyscraper by the Yarra River in the heart of the Southbank precinct.

High up on the 88th floor, 285 metres above sea level, you'll find Melbourne's greatest point of view, and one of the most stunning observation decks in the world.
